Alex is the recipient of the 2023 Jane Vermeullen Leadership State Award from the Michigan Developmental Disabilities Institute, at Wayne State University, for his outstanding work in self-determination and advocacy.

Alex lays the foundation for attendees in this course for an autistic-led think-tank on development of self-determination skills and goal attainment through an autistic lens.

This session focuses on moving beyond awareness to true acceptance of neurodiversity, embracing and celebrating individual differences. Alexander Kimmel will engage participants with interactive discussions on identity-first language, self-determination, personalized needs, social norms, and neurodiversity, all through the lens of autism. The workshop incorporates humor, video clips, and participant involvement, making it an engaging and impactful experience.

Time is embedded in the session for self-reflection and discussion on the role of norms, acceptance, autistic neurology and, of course, self-determination.
